# Introduction

The readings provided in this document are provided to allow the laity and clergy of the Scottish Episcopal Church to read the bible together every day of the year. They are suitable for reading in the context of Daily Prayer either in church or at home.

Most days, three readings are provided. These may be distributed as seems appropriate in the local context. For those saying morning and evening prayer, it may be appropriate to read the Old Testament and Gospel at Morning Prayer and the New Testament and Gospel at Evening Prayer.

## How the Daily Prayer tables work

In the columns printed here, the first column indicates the day of the month.

The second column indicates the liturgical colour:

W – White R – Red G – Green V – Violet

The third column indicates what liturgical day it is.

The fourth column indicates which set of prayers from Daily Prayer are to be used on that day.

The last three columns give the readings for the day. On most days three readings are given. On important feast days separate readings are suggested for morning and evening.

# Sunday Lectionary Readings from the Scottish Lectionary

This Kalendar includes this table following repeated requests for the inclusion of the readings that most churches use on a Sunday for their main service. Many churches derive their own lectionary tables from the Revised Common Lectionary, including the Church of Scotland, the Roman Catholic Church and other churches in the Anglican Communion. The table below is the Scottish Episcopal Church's own use of this lectionary. Care should always be taken when using resources from other churches as there are occasions where a local church departs from the RCL and the different churches number their Sundays differently.

Four readings are provided for each Sunday – an Old Testament Reading, a Psalm which is chosen to respond to that reading (ie a responsorial psalm), a New Testament Reading and a Gospel.

During Ordinary Time – between Pentecost 3 and Christ the King, there are two tracks provided for the Old Testament – the first, which allows the Old Testament readings to stand on their own and which relate to one another from week to week and the second, which attempts to use the Old Testament in relation to the Gospel Reading for the day. One track should be chosen and stuck to each year. Swapping between the tracks risks repeating readings. The psalms for Track 1 should only be used in connection with the readings in Track 1 and the psalms for Track 2 should only be used with Track 2. A responsorial psalm is a psalm which 'responds' to the reading, regardless of the style in which it is said or sung or whether it has repeated responses.

# A summary of the Bishops' Instruction on Fasting and Abstinence

*Note: The following advice is copied from the Kalendar produced by the Scottish Episcopal Church in 1991. It is not believed that these comments have been updated since then though many now will be surprised at the notion that no-one could realistically be expected to live without eating meat.*

## DEFINITIONS

**Fasting:** A reduction in the quantity of food and drink consumed during the day.

**Abstinence:** Abstaining from some particular kind of food – traditionally meat.

Note. The Bishops consider that changing circumstances and social habits necessitate adjustments from time to time in the practise of these disciplines. Present circumstances tend to make abstinence from meat unreal, but this ought not to mean that Fasting and Abstinence should cease to be practised.

## THE BISHOP'S RECOMMENDATIONS

- i. That Fasting be observed by partaking of only one solid meal in the day; other meals to be of a light character.
- ii. That Abstinence be observed by abstaining from some form of food or drink which is normally enjoyed. It is to be noted that for this purpose tobacco and sweets may be considered as forms of food.
- iii. Ash Wednesday and good Friday are to be regarded by members of the Church as of obligation; and as days of Fasting and Abstinence.
- iv. That other days ought to be observed in a spirit of voluntary devotion. These are:

### **Days of Fasting:**

The Vigils of Christmas, Easter, and Whitsun.

The Fridays in the four Ember Season.

One of the Rogation Days.

### **Days of Abstinence:**

All other Fridays throughout the year, except Christmas Day, Epiphany and the Fridays in the Octaves of Christmas, Easter and the Ascension of our Lord.

- v. The whole of Lent, except the Sundays, is a time for special self-denial, which should find expression in Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. We encourage all members of the Church to make their own rule of general self-discipline to be observed throughout this season. Such a rule would include additional time for prayer and Bible reading, greater frequency in receiving Holy Communion, and increased giving to the service of Christ by spending less on self.

## Summer Time

Clocks go forward at 1 am on Sunday 30 March 2025 which is the Fourth Sunday in Lent.

Clocks go back at 2 am on Sunday 26 October 2025 which is Pentecost 20

## Season of Creation

The Faith and Order Board and the College of Bishops have proposed the experimental introduction of a Season of Creation from the first Sunday of September for four weeks each year. General Synod has not approved this change.
